

Five Men Killed in Premature Explosion

BERKELEY SPRINGS, W. Va., June 7.—(AP)—Five men were killed and seven injured, two seriously, in a premature explosion of dynamite which engulfed them in a slide of sand following the blast at the sand pit of the Berkeley Glass Sand company near here late today. The men killed were Irvin Henry, George Walls, Emory Miller, Romanis Dawson and George Miller.

The dead men, all of whom leave families, except Dawson, and those injured, were residents of Berkeley Springs.

Company officials and county authorities who made a preliminary inquiry, said a further investigation of the accident would be made tomorrow.
