

**Two Trapped In
Mine 36 Hours
Are Rescued**

WALLACE, Idaho, March 18.—
(By Associated Press.)—Clarence
McMurray and Dan Knuppenberg,
miners trapped on the 1800-foot
level of the Morning Mine for more
than 36 hours, were rescued this
morning.

Rescue workers penetrated the
final six feet of rock and debris
in less than an hour and the two
men were taken from the mine
tunnel uninjured. They were
trapped by a cave-in Tuesday aft-
ernoon when walls of a tunnel in
which they were working collapsed.
George Snew, another miner,
escaped at the time of the cave-in.

During most of the time the
rescuers were able to talk with the
two men.
