killed by a fall of rock, in Old Ben Coal Corporation's No. 18 mine. He leaves a widow and one child.

February 21, Joe Polsenello, trackman, age 32 years, single, was killed by falling rock in Pratt Bros. Coal Company's mine.

February 23, William M. Weaver, loader, age 50 years, married, was killed in Cosgrove-Meehan Coal Company's No. 1 mine, by a fall of rock. He leaves a widow and one child.

March 28, Neil Gilbert, miner, age 52 years, married, was killed by a fall of rock in City Lake Coal Company's mine. He leaves a widow and three children.

April 5, Harry Wilson, mine examiner, age 53 years, married, was killed in Consolidated Coal Company's Lake Creek mine by an explosion of gas. He leaves a widow and one child.

August 1, Vito Cusimiono, miner, age 33 years, married, was killed by falling rock in Puritan Coal Company's mine. He leaves a widow and four children.

October 29, Cesare Zanini, shot firer, age 44 years, married, was instantly killed by a fall of rock in Cosgrove-Meehan Coal Company's No. 1 mine. He leaves a widow and two children.

November 8, I. E. Arnold, loader, age 39 years, married, died from the effects of injuries received the day before when he was caught by a fall of rock, in Cosgrove-Meehan Coal Company's No. 1 mine.

November 30, Willis Stricklin, miner, age 50 years, married, was killed in Consolidated Coal Company's Lake Creek mine by falling roof. He leaves a widow and one child.

December 20, an explosion of gas occurred in Gosgrove-Meehan Coal Company's No. 1 mine, Johnston City, by which seven men lost their lives. The cause of the ignition is not known, as all the men working in this section of the mine were killed.
