

Iron Miner Gets A Bravery Medal

DULUTH, Minn., June 23 (A)—Thomas Trewartha, middle aged iron miner from Ironwood, Mich., was given the Josph H. Holmes medal for heroism at the banquet of Lake Superior Mining section of the National Safety council last night.

It was Trewartha, shift boss at the Pabst mine at Ironwood, who was credited with saving the lives of 42 miners by his coolness when the miners were entombed for five days in the eighth level of the mine in September, 1926.

Trewartha, a native of Cornwall, England, has been employed by the Oliver Mining Co. for forty years:
