

Entombed Miners Rescued.

Shamokin, Dec. 3.—Twenty-one hours after they had been entombed in the Hickory Swamp slope of the Luke Fidler colliery, near here, two men were rescued alive today, without a scratch to show for their experience. The men, John Kowloski, and Wasil Rapunski, both of Shamokin, became entombed yesterday when a shot of dynamite they had fired brought down tons of coal and earth, blocking the slope in which they were working. Wives of the two men, when told they did not return home last night, became alarmed and mine officials began an investigation. It was the first day's work for both men as miners.
