

DRILLER ENTOMBED IN TUNNEL RESCUED

MARSHFIELD (Or) July 7. (P)-Ben Bennettson of Portland was rescued today from a tunnel at the Hauser Construction Company quarry on Coos River after being entombed for twenty four hours. Bennettson was drilling a tunnel underneath a rock cliff for a charge of dynamite when a rock slide of hundreds of tons shut off the entrance. than 100 men had worked to release him. Air in the tunnel and air filtering through the rocks saved him and he was able to walk when brought to daylight.
