

## DRILLER ENTOMBED IN TUNNEL RESCUED

MARSHFIELD (Or) July 7. (AP)—  
Ben Bennettson of Portland was res-  
cued today from a tunnel at the  
Hauser Construction Company rock  
quarry on Coos River after being en-  
tombbed for twenty four hours. Ben-  
nettson was drilling a tunnel under-  
neath a rock cliff for a charge of dy-  
namite when a rock slide of hundreds  
of tons shut off the entrance. More  
than 100 men had worked to release  
him. Air in the tunnel and air fil-  
tering through the rocks saved him  
and he was able to walk when  
brought to daylight.
