TO ENFORCE STATE MINE REGULATIONS

Mine inspectors of the State Department of Mines have been explicitly instructed by Walter G. Glasgow, Secretary of the department, to make a special effort to determine that all mining operators, both biand anthracite, comply tuminous with the State regulations.

The special instructions went out. Secretary Glasgow said, as a result of the recent findings of inspectors blaming the explosion in the Irvona mine at Coalport which caused the death of thirteen miners on carelessness of the mine manage-The inspectors and a coroner's jury found there was gas in the mine at the time of the blast, believed to have been caused by a spark from machinery.
