

RESCUED FROM MINE, DIES OF PNEUMONIA

Mather, Pa., May 28.—(AP)—Entombed for more than six days in the ruins of Mather mine, after an explosion there last Saturday afternoon, John Wade, 38, a Negro coal loader, Saturday was reunited for a brief time with his wife and three children, but late in the day died of pneumonia, which developed suddenly due to his long exposure.
