Welch, W. Va.—At a coroner's inquest Monday the cause of the explosion in the Yukon-Pocahontas Mines on May 22 when seventeen miners were killed, was attributed to a mine door being left open. Gas accumulated and workmen failed to make tests with a safety lamp, it was found.
