

RACE MEN DIE IN MINE BLAST

BLUEFIELD, W. Va., May 31.—
(P. N. S.)—Of the 17 miners listed
as victims of the explosion in the
No. 1 mine of the Yukon-Pocahontas
Coal Company at Yukon, McDowell
county, Tuesday, eight were race
men. Thirteen of the bodies were
badly mangled and made identifica-
tion practically impossible.

It is said that 40 men were in
the workings at the time of the
blast and 23 escaped through the
main entry.
