

FIFTH BODY RECOVERED FROM CALAVERAS MINE

COPPEROPOLIS, Sept. 11.—The last of the five men to be buried in the Calaveras Copper Mine last week was reached late yesterday by the men who have been working desperately ever since the cavein occurred. Like his four companions, he was dead when found.

Gonzales Gonzales, 30, was the last man whose body was taken from the shaft. He lived in Copperopolis and his parents had been at the head of the mine shaft ever since the cavein occurred in the hope that he might have been in some protected crevice at the time of the slide.
