

TWO NEVADANS BURIED ALIVE

One Is Rescued Alive But Suffers Terribly From Shock

TWIN FALLS, Idaho, Mar. 25.—
(UP)—Two men were buried alive
in the shaft of the Delano copper
mine at Contact, Nevada, when a
cave-in occurred there at 9 o'clock
this morning, according to meager
telephone reports received here.

The men were Jack Chambers
and Charles Chambers, brothers,
who have been employed at the
mine.

Charles Chambers was rescued
alive at noon in a severely shocked
condition after workers had tun-
neled through debris on the 100-
foot level for three hours. The
rescue squad was directed by faint
cries of the victim.

Although the two brothers were
working together when the tunnel
collapsed, no trace of Jack was
found in the mass of ore surround-
ing Charles.

A relief squad is pushing on
through the ore in an endeavor to
locate the other miner.
