

MINER ESCAPES DEATH WHEN MINE COLLAPSES

POMEROY, Jan. 28—Harry France, a miner in the Blackstone Coal mine at Rutland, a few miles north of here, narrowly escaped death today when he was completely covered by slate and stone as a part of the mine collapsed.

The falling stone and slate miraculously fell in such a way that the miner suffered only cuts and bruises. His calls for help summoned fellow-workmen, who rescued him a short time later.
