

## 9 Men Trapped By Mine Cave

Rescued Uninjured Few  
Hours Later From Ply-  
mouth Working

Nine men were trapped yesterday morning at the Plymouth Red Ash colliery by a cave-in and excitement ran high as reports of loss of life spread. A crowd outside the slope waited anxiously for news from the inside until officials calmed their fears with the prediction that there were probably no fatalities.

The entombed men were released uninjured shortly after noon after being imprisoned a few hours. Excellent rescue facilities were responsible for the quick delivery.

New forces of men were put to work after the rescue clearing away the debris. Timber men following them restored damaged props.
