

FOUR MINERS RESCUED.

Shenandoah, Pa., April 29 (T)—Four imprisoned miners were rescued today after 15 hours behind a fall of coal in the Hammond collieries near Girardville. Meantime two others were trapped and probably fatally injured while working in an abandoned mine near Centralia. The four were rescued after a crew of 20 men had worked cautiously all night lest their boring loosen more coal. They kept up communication with the prisoners through a compressed air pipe. N
