

Gassed Miner Recovers
Marked improvement is reported in the condition of Garfield Gray, 700 Ottawa street, who was overcome by gas Monday at the Midway mine while extinguishing fire among timbers underground. Gray was dismissed from Picher hospital yesterday, where he was taken after being gassed. When taken to the hospital he was in a semi-conscious condition and it was several hours before he fully regained consciousness. In becoming overcome by the gas he fell to the ground, being discovered by fellow-workmen within a few minutes.
