**Miner Rescued After Seven Days in Mine**

Fairmont, W. Va., Oct. 14.—(AP)—For seven days and seven nights, without food or water and groping in utter darkness, Charles Montgomery, 34, wandered helplessly through the maze of an abandoned section of a coal mine at nearby Downs.

Hardly able to walk, his shoes cut to pieces by jagged slats in the old mine tunnels, the weary miner was rescued far from the point at which he had entered the workings.

"Give me a drink of water," was his first cry after two members of the rescue party found him scrambling
