

Miner Escapes Death in Cave-in

SONORA, Oct. 20. — Ed Wilcox, 30, ^{year}miner at the McCormick Mine near Jacksonville, narrowly escaped death in a cave-in on the 180-foot level yesterday when a portion of the tunnel roof fell on him. He saw the slide coming as he was working and attempted to get out, but both of his legs were caught. The left leg was broken in two places, and the right knee was injured.

Wilcox was pinned in the tunnel for two hours while fellow miners worked to dig him out from under the dirt. He was rushed to the Sonora Hospital by ambulance and treated by Dr. H. D. Rose.
