

Miner Rescued From Cave-In

QUINCY — Imprisoned for hours by a rock slide in the Feather river canyon, Frank Bane, 62, miner, was recovering in a hospital here Saturday because his dog hovered close to him and kept him warm and because rescue workers refused to give up efforts to save him.

He was extricated by sixteen men, who worked feverishly to extricate him when he was pinned beneath a mass of rocks and dirt that broke both his legs, a shoulder and several ribs. He was brought to Quincy on a stretcher.
