

Youth Buried in Mine Hole More Than Six Hours

Joseph Symborski, 21, Has Narrow Escape From Death Near R. R. Cut West of Elmwood.

Imprisoned by a fall of earth and silt for more than six hours, Joseph Symborski, 21-year old Mahanoy City young man, was released from a mine hole in the vicinity of the old Lehigh Valley railroad cut west of the Elmwood slope Wednesday evening.

Given emergency medical attention by Dr. D. A. Holland, P. & R. C. & I. Company physician, Symborski was then removed to the Locust Mountain hospital in the company ambulance, where further treatment was given.

Examination made following his admittance failed to reveal any fractured bones, but x-rays will be taken today to fully determine the nature of his injuries.

Reports from the institution last evening and today said that his condition was improving. His injuries were announced as contusions of the body.
