

MAN TRAPPED IN MINE RESCUED AFTER 6 HOURS

Pottsville, Pa., Nov. 5 (U.P.)—Charles Barr, of Pine Grove, today was reported recovering from a harrowing experience of being entombed for more than six hours in an abandoned mine shaft.

A rush of earth and coal trapped Barr in the abandoned workings at the Lincoln colliery. Twenty men digging in shifts rescued him.
