

MINER IS RESCUED FROM RUSH CULM

Frank Houser, 44, of Tremont, had a miraculous escape from death by suffocation when he was buried yesterday under a rush of coal near his home while engaged with other workmen in screening culm from an abandoned bank. He was caught in a hole when the sides collapsed and was held prisoner 15 minutes before fellow toilers effected his rescue. Houser, victim of internal injuries and shock, was removed to the Pottsville hospital.
