

TRAPPED IN COAL HOLE; IS RESCUED UNHURT

Harold Dinger, son of Mr. and Mrs. H. Dinger, of Donaldson, was entombed in a bootleg mine hole in Upper Donaldson on Thursday morning, when a rush of coal and debris covered him as he and a group of men including his father and brothers were working the hole.

He was rescued practically uninjured a short time after being closed in.

The group, including his father, H. Dinger, a brother, Lester, Herman and Harry Myers were working the coal hole with Harold in the hole digging. He dislodged a large rock which precipitated the slide. Aside from shock and bruises he was uninjured.
