

Entombed Miner Rescued

POTTSVILLE, May 22. (AP)—Entombed for seven hours, James Farrell, of Lorberry Junction, near Pine Grove was rescued tonight from a mine hole in which he was digging coal.

Rushed to a hospital, he was treated for shock and held for observation of possible internal injuries.

Farrell was digging with another man on a private mining property when the timbers gave way and buried him under a rush of earth. His companion escaped.
