

CITY MINER TRAPPED IN A FALL AT MINE

Buried beneath a fall of coal, Joseph Swelgoskie, of 853 North Washington street, suffered possible fractures of small bones of his left foot this afternoon at the Dorrance colliery of the Lehigh Valley Coal Company. He was rescued by fellow workmen within a few minutes after the fall occurred. Admitted to General Hospital, Swelgoskie was reported in good condition at 3:30 o'clock.
