

## Miner Trapped 16 Hours Is Released Unharmed

PLACERVILLE, CALIF., Nov. 28. (AP)—Rescued after being entombed by a mine cavein for 16 hours, during which his wife and young daughter shouted encouragement to him, Owen W. Terry, tonight declared he would return to his job despite his harrowing experience.

Terry, superintendent of the Harmon mine, near here, apparently was uninjured but was stiff and sore from being pinioned by heavy timbers, which prevented a huge boulder from crushing him.

He was trapped yesterday afternoon by the rock fall which killed William Stonerook, a miner.
