Safe at Home Now And  
"Getting Warm" Again.

CHARLESTON, W. Va., Nov. 14.  
—(P)—Toni Tianosi is getting warm tonight.

"You bet I'm cold," was his most frequent complaint as he crouched behind a huge pile of slate and jagged rock deep in a coal mine—imprisoned for more than 24 hours in a tiny wet niche in the mine wall.

Rescued by fellow-workers who labored day and night, working in 20-minute shifts to dig him a tunnel to freedom, he was taken to his home—to bed, to rest, and most important in Toni's opinion, to get warm.
