

## Trapped Miner Rescued Alive

**Edward Kimmel, of Near Taylorsville, Held Prisoner Four Hours.**

Trapped in an independent mine operation at West Glendower, in the Heckscherville Valley, Edward Kimmel, 30, of near Taylorsville, was rescued alive four hours later and escaped with comparatively minor injuries.

Kimmel and two fellow workers were driving an independent mine hole when the workings suddenly collapsed, trapping Kimmel back of the fall. His companions summoned aid from nearby holes, and within a short time a large force of men was engaged in removing debris, which had to be hoisted to the surface. After four hours, the mass of rock and coal was penetrated and Kimmel was found alive back of the fall, having been protected by a jutting rib of the working place.

A physician had been summoned to the scene and gave Kimmel medical and surgical attention immediately following his rescue. He was conveyed to his home where he is expected to recover.
