

TRAPPED 8 HOURS, MINER IS RESCUED

POTTSVILLE, Pa., April 11 (AP)—

Roy Gauntlett, 32, late today was rescued from an abandoned mine working at nearby Newtown Hill, where he was held trapped by a fall of coal for eight hours.

Gauntlett was taken to a hospital to be treated for exposure and exhaustion. A score of men tunneled through the fall to the spot where he was buried, while he directed the rescue.
