

Miners Trapped In Cage.

Ten miners were imprisoned in a mine cage 350 feet underground for four hours yesterday, when safety catches on a cage jammed as the men were being lowered into the Hammond mine at Girardville.

Repairmen descended into the 750-foot deep shaft and freed the trapped workers.

More than 500 miners were forced to return to their homes, when a Tamden cage in another shaft also jammed, throwing the colliery into temporary idleness.
