

TWO MEN TRAPPED IN MINE RESCUE

Cumberland, Md., Feb. 16— (UP) —Christopher Krause, 55, and William Griffith, Jr., 30, were safe in their homes today, unharmed except for the 16-hour exposure to mine gases while imprisoned in the shaft of Consolidation mine under a fall of rock.

The men were trapped at midnight Thursday, and rescue crews began the tedious task of removing the heavy rock and debris. Rescue was effected late yesterday after relay crews labored 16 hours.
