

TWO RESCUED

Pittsburgh, March 11. (AP) — Two miners, intombed 300 feet underground, were rescued by 60 of their fellows tonight who dug untiringly for eight hours.

The men, Gasper Kern, 51, and Mike Kurimsky, 20, were uninjured but exhausted. They were given first aid and ordered to bed.

The pair were trapped in No. 6 mine of the Union Collieries com-

pany at Newfield this morning after tons of rock fell, cutting off their escape.

Fellow workers dug for five hours, not knowing whether the men were dead or alive. Finally they heard voices and redoubled their efforts. They dug through 30 feet of debris, about a mile and a half in the mine, before reaching the men.
