

Coal Digger Rescued In Hole at Greenwood

Arthur Ulko, 18, 3301 Pittston Avenue, was saved from death yesterday afternoon at 3:30 o'clock by several companions after he was pinned in a hole while digging coal in Greeenwood.

A slide of rock is reported to have caught Ulko and buried his left leg. Friends succeeded in removing the rock and had him taken to the office of Dr. Serafine Wandalowski, 1419 North Main Avenue.

Ulko's injuries were described as brush burns of the left leg and left arm. He also suffered from shock.
