

SIX KILLED BY BLAST

Three Missing After Explosion Sweeps State Quarry at Delta, Pa.

DELTA, Pa., Nov. 30 (U.P.).—A state quarry near here was rocked by a disastrous explosion today. Six men were killed.

The blast was believed caused by dynamite and occurred in a tunnel at the Funkhouser company quarry.

F. M. Irwin, Delta police chief, said that only two of those killed were identified immediately and that workers were seeking the bodies of others in the debris torn loose by the blast.

The two identified were Roy Ayres and Lee Jones. They were not employes, but had gone to the quarry to get an automobile which they were to repair.

The tunnel was wrecked by the blast.
