

MAN BURIED BY CAVE-IN RESCUED AFTER ONE HOUR

Herbert Thimm, 37, of 4731 Beacon avenue, an oiler for the Modern Sand and Gravel Company, was buried in a sand cave-in at the company's plant at the foot of Rutgers street for more than an hour yesterday morning, but was rescued uninjured by police and firemen.

Thimm entered an opening in a loading station when a sandslide started from a large pile. Thimm grasped the sides of the opening to keep his head from being buried and fellow workmen put a steel cylinder about his head to prevent suffocation.

Police and firemen put ropes under Thimm's armpits and he was dragged out.
