

Two Bodies Taken From Mine Shaft After Blast

LOUISVILLE, Colo. (UP) Bodies of two miners were removed today from the Monarch No. 2 coal mine where an explosion occurred yesterday.

Rescue squads found the bodies near the spot where the miners were trying to isolate a fire which has been burning for years.

The dead were Lee Ward, 44, and Walter Novinnger, 36, of Bloomfield, Colo.

Six other miners were entombed by the explosion and it was expected that all them would be found dead.
