

Miner Trapped By Rock Fall

Lansford Man Walks Away After Being Freed 3½ Hours Later

Joseph Filowic, W. Abott St., Lansford, a miner at the Coaldale colliery of the Lehigh Navigation Coal Co., was closed in by a fall of top rock while at work yesterday morning at 9 a. m.

Rescue crews were at once rushed to the scene and worked feverishly until 12.30 p. m. when they freed the man, who was working on the East Primrose vein on the fourth level.

Filowic, after being freed, was able to walk home evidently none the worse for his experience.
