

BOY IS RESCUED FROM COAL HOLE

Dorne Starkey, 15, Mahanoy City, was buried under a slide of rock in a coal hole just north of the Reading Company depot at Mahanoy City shortly before noon Saturday while his companion, Walter McClarne, 17, narrowly escaped the rush.

McClaren rushed into Mahanoy City to summon aid, and within a short time Chief Burgess P. J. Foley led a force of men to the scene to find Starkey trapped with heavy rocks pressing against his right ankle. With considerable difficulty the youth was rescued alive and found to have escaped with a crushed ankle and suffering from shock.
