

Imprisoned Miner Freed After 4 Hours

John Zankoskie, 50, Brady, was trapped for four hours in a rush of coal in the Primrose vein of the Philadelphia & Reading Coal & Iron Company's Reliance Colliery, near Mount Carmel. Throughout the greater part of the miners' period of imprisonment, Dr. A. B. Buczko, company compensation surgeon in the Mount Carmel district, was at the unfortunate man's side, administering surgical and medical treatment and aiding in maintaining his morale.

Dr. Buczko accompanied the injured man to the Shamokin Hospital, where he is now under treatment for a mangled right leg and shock. He is expected to recover.
