

# 14 KILLED IN MINE BLAST

## Bureau of Mines Reports Alaskan Explosion—Cause Is Mystery

WASHINGTON, Oct. 27.—(INS) —Fourteen men were killed and one seriously injured in a coal mine explosion at Jonesville, Alaska, late yesterday, according to the Bureau of Mines today from Col. O. F. Ohlson, general manager of the Alaskan Railroad Company at Anchorage.

Colonel Ohlson said the cause of the explosion had not been determined. Two doctors, four nurses and the railroad's mine rescue force were sent to the scene.
