

TWO RESCUED FROM CAVE-IN

MONTELLLO, Nev., Jan. 13--(UP)
—Entombed for a day 300 feet underground, two men were rescued from the Delano mine today and brought to Montello, suffering little ill effects.

The miners, Jess Baker and a man named Harris, were trapped by a cave-in at the mine. Rescuers led by Constable Bill Hargrave and Justice of the Peace Maine W. Johnson succeeding in penetrating the tons of rock and dirt and opened a passage to the two men today.

Over ice-covered roads the men and the rescue party reached Montello safely this afternoon from the mine, isolated near the Utah line 35 miles north of here.
