

MAN UNINJURED IN MINE CAVE-IN

W. E. Church Is Freed by Fellow Workers After Fifteen Hours.

Apparently none the worse for his experience after 15 hours' imprisonment underground in the Badger mine, William E. Church, 61, stepped out of the earth early yesterday morning and thanked fellow workers who had struggled vigorously to free him. He was trapped from 10 a. m. Tuesday until about 1 a. m. yesterday.

Church, with three companions, had been working on a sill over a fill stope, when the ground gave way. Church dropped 18 feet. His companions could hear his cries for help but could not see him. They gave reassurance as they worked. Church was protected by the timbers from rock and earth pressure.

His residence is at 118 East Broadway.
