

RESCUED FROM COAL HOLE

Entombed six hours, Nicholas Wisneskie, of 1719 Tioga street, Shamokin, was rescued Saturday night from a coal hole near the St. Francis cemetery at Shamokin.

Protection afforded by a large slab of rock which fell in a leaning position against the side of a mine buggy, saved Wisneskie from being crushed.

The entombed man, who refused to be taken to the hospital, is now at his home apparently only slightly injured.
