Praco Mine Victims Removed from Trap

DIRMINGHAM, ALA., July 3.— A white flag awarded to the Praco Mine near Birmingham for its safety record was taken down late yesterday after rescuers removed the last of six bodies from a hole where workers were trapped Friday by a cave-in. The last two men removed died soon after they were reached by rescuers. The victims were trapped and crushed when a rock-fall occurred while miners were boring between two shafts at a 3,000-foot level underground.
