

## TWO RESCUED FROM BOOTLEG MINE HOLE

SHENANDOAH, June 9 (U.P.)—Andrew Engle, 52, was reported in fair condition at Locust Mountain Hospital today after he and his 19-year-old son were rescued from a fall of rock and coal 100 feet below the surface in a bootleg coal hole near here.

The elder Engle, rescued after five hours' entombment, was covered to the neck by the fall. His son, rescued after two hours, was unhurt.
