

Bootleg Miner Overcome By Fumes Of Gas Engine

Dominick Pabulis, 21, of Kulpmont narrowly escaped death and is in the Shamokin State Hospital suffering from the effects of gas fumes as the result of having been overcome while at work in a bootleg mine near Kulpmont Tuesday afternoon.

Pabulis was felled when he inhaled carbon monoxide fumes generated by an old automobile engine used to operate a pump in the mine. He was found in an unconscious condition by fellow workers and although his condition was for a time serious he showed improvement today.
