

## RESCUED FROM COAL HOLE

Pottsville, Pa., Jan. 10 (AP).—Frank Mischurski, thirty-four, of Minersville, was rescued yesterday from a makeshift coal hole in which he had been trapped for fourteen hours.

At Pottsville hospital, physicians said he suffered bruises and nervous breakdown.

Mischurski and a companion were in the coal hole when debris caved in upon them. The companion leaped to safety but Mischurski was pinned so he could not work his way out.

Other miners dug through to reach him.
