

Lake Lynn Man Saved From Death in Coal Bin

UNIONTOWN, Nov. 22.—
Trapped in a large coal bin after
he saved himself from probable
serious injuries by catching a two-
by-four beam, Millard Johnson,
27, held on for nearly half an hour
before his screams attracted a
trucker, Leslie Morgan, of near
Gans who rescued the Lake Lynn
man a few minutes before a heavy
car of coal dumped into the bin.

Johnson was mending the track
end at the Wilson mine, operated
by J. L. Corbin of Lake Lynn,
when he fell into the bin.
