

BODY OF MAN LOCATED UNDER TONS OF DEBRIS

**Two Other Men Taken From Coal
Hole Not Seriously Injured**

MAHANOEY CITY, Nov. 17 (AP)
—Rescue workers found Edison Schlauch, 34, of Nuremberg dead yesterday under tons of debris in a coal hole two miles northeast of here.

Two companions, Anthony Nackoviski, 21, and Peter Bogdanovicz, 31, both of Shenandoah, R. R., were rescued. Both suffered shock and exposure but otherwise were uninjured.

Deputy Coroner Frank Boczkowski of Mahanoy City said the cave-in buried Schlauch but that the two other men were caught near the roof of the hole in such a way that they were able to breathe.
